Once you've set up your method of composting, whether outdoor, vermi-composting, or municipal green bin collection, you're ready to start separating your food scraps from the rest of your garbage.

- Before collecting food waste, make sure that everyone is aware of what can and cannot be placed in your compost bin.
- Food scraps collected after meals must be weighed (in kg) at the end of each day. Make sure that you are not including the weight of the container. Weigh an empty container first, and then subtract that from your total weight of the container which has food scraps in it.
- Note that the weight you record is for the food scraps before they go into the compost and **not** the rich, dark soil which results from the compost process.
