



Anti-Idling Worksheet

- Each Anti-idling campaign consists of three parts; an initial audit, the campaign itself and the follow-up audit. You may choose to run the campaign as many times as you like throughout the school year, but each separate campaign must have these three sections to ensure that your school's carbon savings are properly calculated.

Before starting, decide:

- How long you want the campaign to run (school year, 1 month, 2 months...)
- If you would like to run the campaign more than once
- The duration of each audit. Doing the audit for more than one day provides a better estimate of the occurrence of idling at your school, however it's best to keep it under a week.

Recording Data

- If a car is found idling, start the timer
- As soon as the car is either turned off or drives away, stop the timer
- Record the duration of idling in the chart below
- Each car found idling during the audit will be numbered and its corresponding idling time recorded
